FOAM PUMPKINS MAY BE CARVED OR CUT.

- Your child should think of a favorite book and design their pumpkin based on their favorite character from that book.
- Purchase a pumpkin that is no larger in size than a basketball.
- Gather your decorating supplies. Acrylic paints or permanent markers work best. Watercolors tend to run, and spray paint will gradually dissolve the pumpkin. Other options include adding materials such as yarn, buttons, wiggly eyes, etc.
- Decorate your pumpkin without carving, cutting, or poking holes in it. If you are using a foam craft pumpkin, you may carve, cut, or poke.
- Print out and answer the questions on the following entry page.
- Bring your pumpkin and entry page to the library beginning Monday, October
 29th upon arrival to school.

Pumpkins are to be taken home at the end of school on Friday, November 1st. If your child needs assistance getting it home please make arrangements to do this. All pumpkins that are left behind will be disposed of by 4:15 that afternoon. Participation is completely voluntary. This is not a contest. Have fun and be creative!
